- **Transforming adult psychiatric care:** We are one part of a community-wide effort to care for people with psychiatric needs. People are most successful in managing their mental health and coping with symptoms when there is a coordinated plan involving primary care providers, outpatient-based services and the hospital-based care team. Our new state-of-the-art Adult Psychiatry Unit will support our team to provide exceptional inpatient acute psychiatric care with an emphasis on hope, recovery, quality of life and success beyond the facility's walls. Included in this unit is a dedicated space, the Medical Village, which offers patients the opportunity to connect with community partner agencies that will support their transition to outpatient care.
- **Improving the quality and efficiency of care:** Capitalizing on the implementation of the Epic electronic medical record system, we are taking a huge step toward creating a seamless patient experience for patients across The UVM Health Network. This system is an important tool in our efforts to improve the quality and effectiveness of care by giving providers their patients' most updated medical information.
- **Commitment to building a diverse and dynamic workforce:** We continue to work toward becoming a more diverse, equitable and inclusive (DEI) organization with the completion of a confidential cultural assessment, ongoing educational opportunities and planned training for leaders. Advancing our DEI work is key to fulfilling our mission to best care for our patients and each other.
