PORTER MEDICAL CENTER KEY INITIATIVES

- **Integration of care** at Porter Medical Center and across the UVM Health Network is now supported by a new electronic medical records system. The system means providers will have quick and secure access to patient information across all Porter care settings and throughout the Network.
- **Confronting COVID-19 in our community** has been a top priority since the pandemic began. In addition to caring for patients with the virus in our emergency department and inpatient unit, we operate a testing center and offer monoclonal antibody treatment. These outpatient services are expanded during local surges to ensure we can meet the health care needs of our community.
- **Community collaborations** to address issues identified in our community health needs assessment. We recently took on the mission and volunteers of End of Life Services, a non-profit hospice care agency, to support the expansion and integration of our palliative medicine and end-of-life services. Other collaborations involve plans with community agencies to address mental health access, affordable housing, accessible childcare and health equity issues.
- **We are committed to caring for our most vulnerable citizens** at Helen Porter Rehabilitation & Nursing Center. Upgrades are planned for several areas of our facility in order to sustain it as a crucial community resource and improve capacity for post-acute patients. This includes, in the near term, a renovation of our courtyard, one of the facility's most beloved spaces.
